Committee Participation Attendance Policy

Because the Arcadia Association of REALTORS® Committees are vital to the function and success of the Association as a whole and an integral part of the Association, the Committees must meet a quorum of members (51% of the Committee roster present) within each of their meetings, in order to pass motions on important items discussed.

In order to achieve this necessity, it is the policy of the Arcadia Association of REALTORS® that any member of a Committee must attend 75% of the Committee meetings in a year. Upon the third absence, the Committee member will be contacted by the Committee Chair and notified of the occurrence of the third absence and given a courtesy notice of their removal from the Committee. Exceptions that will not count toward absences and removal include, Arcadia Association of REALTORS® business, National Association of REALTORS® business, California Association of REALTORS® business, serious illness, and family emergencies.

If a member is removed from a Committee due to absence, they can reinstate their participation in the Committee by attending a future meeting held.
